Me: "I *know* you said 'Why what' !"

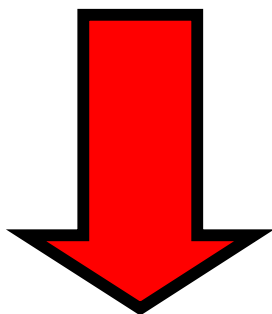
Him: "What?!"
